

NCC Financial Need Scholarship

This scholarship assists students in extreme financial need with the cost of their education. Students must be matriculated into a degree-granting program, be in good academic standing, have a minimum CGPA of 2.0 or be a first semester freshman or transfer student, have financial need, and have completed a current FAFSA. International students are not eligible for these funds.
